ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

The Beautillion Season is open to eleventh (11th) and twelfth (12th) grade high school African American males. A School verification form is required.

ATTIRE

Beaux: Black tuxedo with tails, white shirt, black bowtie, black cummerbund and white gloves.

Belles: Long white dress (no strapless), white gloves and white shoes

Fathers: Black tuxedo (no tails)

Mothers: Formal wear (floor length or ankle length)

REGISTRATION FEE

The cost is a \$400.00 fee per beau. The registration fee covers all planned activities, including a T-Shirt and four tickets (Beau, Belle and Beau's parents) to the Ball Presentation.

A minimum deposit of \$100.00 is required with the completed application. The final payment of \$300.00 is due on or before July 31, 2019.

REFUND POLICY

All fees paid to Fun-Set Social and Charity Club are not refundable in full or in part. This policy applies (but is not limited) to registration fees, advertising fees and ticket sales. If a participant withdraws from the Beautillion Season, he will not receive a refund of any fees.

TICKET AND AD SALES

The success of the Beautillion Ball is a partnership between beau families and Fun-Set Social and Charity Club. Beau families are encouraged to sell as many ads and tickets as possible to share in this memorable event. Each beau is required to sell a **minimum of 12 tickets to be eligible to apply for an Academic or Essay Scholarship** (excludes seating of the beau, belle, and beau parents). Each beau is required to purchase two full page ads in addition to all other solicited ads.

AWARDS

The Fun-Set Social and Charity Club proudly offers three types of awards: Scholarship, Essay and Leadership Awards. These awards are designed to promote superior educational standards, enhanced writing skills and leadership development in young African American male high school students. The purpose of the academic awards is considered because of the diverse and inequity opportunity that may impair many students' ability to attend or complete college. These awards were established

to assist deserving student who have demonstrated the ability to compete academically

Academic – This scholarship is offered under the Ammons, Rhodes and Briggs Educational Fund. Four one thousand dollar (\$1000.00) academic awards are given after September 1 following admission to a four year college, university, community college, or trade school.

Essay: The Essay Scholarship is an excellent way to use those writing skills you have been practicing; and to assist with paying for your future educational endeavors.

President's Leadership – This award celebrates one beau who exemplified the following five characteristics throughout the beautillion season. The characteristics are: Love for Jesus and others; knowledgeable; integrity and honesty; communication skills; self-driven.
