In this journey you will be cultivating new skills, gaining new friendships, gaining opportunities to receiving scholarships, engaging in seminars and community service projects with the culmination of the Beautillion Ball at the end of the Season! History of the Fun-Set Social and Charity Club

The Fun Set Social and Charity Club was founded and organized in 1966 by the late Dorothy Bowens-Ammons. She was a native of Jackson, Tennessee. After some research she saw the need to create a social activity in the city of Huntsville. From there she organized a club consisting of African American Women. They named the club the Fun Set Social Club. After a few years the organization saw the need to develop community service and programs focusing on education, health and wellness and community outreach. The organization changed the name to the Fun Set Social and Charity Club.

Our first "Beautillion Ball" was in 1979 at the Carriage Inn Hotel, where thirty young men were presented. Some of the young men presented at that ball and earlier balls have allowed us to present their sons in the ball. To date we have presented more than 1,000 young men to society and a brotherhood that will serve as a support system for many years.

We are a 501(c)(3) organization composed of women dedicated to community service. Our mission continues to focus on support of Young African American males through educational seminars that will empower them to become contributing members of society and to a brotherhood. We strive to participate in community outreach and health and wellness programs.

Expectations for Beau Behavior

  - Respect the rights and privileges of other participants, presenters, and other Fun-Set Social and Charity Club members
  - Respect the property of others including property and facilities
  - Participants must sign in at each activity

Statement of Values/Behaviors

The statement of values (set of principles) is established to develop and maintain a guide of conduct that is acceptable to the Fun-Set Social and Charity Club throughout the beautillion season. The required behaviors are basic, yet critical to demonstrate and promote self-responsibility, and encouragement among brothers.

Requirements for Participation

The Beautillion Season is open to eleventh (11<sup>th</sup>) and twelfth (12<sup>th</sup>) grade high school African American males. Parents will be responsible for school verification. In order to participate in the Beautillion Ball all Beaux must pay the 38<sup>th</sup> Beautillion Ball Season registration fee of \$600.00, complete the Data Presentation form, sell 12 tickets and 2 full-page ads, attend all educational seminars, Parent/Son Brunch, and participate in the community service activity as well as all other Beau activities.

#### **REGISTRATION FEE**

The cost is a \$600.00 fee per beau. The registration fee covers all planned activities: which include Get Acquainted Social, Four Educational Seminars (College 101: ACT Prep and College Research, Know Your Legal Rights, Learning about the Law, Voter Education, Financial Literacy, and more), Parent / Son Brunch, Free Professional Photo Shoot with accommodating free photo, Free 38<sup>th</sup> Annual Souvenir Keepsake Booklet, and Free 2023 Beautillion T-Shirt. Beaus will also have the opportunity to apply for Four Academic Scholarships, Two Essay Scholarships, and Two Community Service Scholarships (Offered by Beulah Ballard Toney Community Service Award). The culmination of the 38<sup>th</sup> Annual Beautillion Ball will be the Presentation of the Beaus to the community on November 18, 2023.

\*\*\*\*Please note the rental of the tuxedo is a separate cost.

A minimum deposit of \$200.00 is required with the completed application. The remaining balance can be paid by August 12, 2023. There will be an opportunity to pay at each informational meeting.

#### **REFUND POLICY**

#### ATTIRE

Beaux will be required to rent their tuxedo from the listed vendor below:

Beaux:	Black tuxedo with tails, white shirt, black bowtie, black
	vest, white gloves, and black shoes. No earrings. Beaux
	must purchase or use their own black dress socks.

Belles: Long white bell-shaped Ball Gown (no strapless), long white gloves, and white or clear shoes (no stilettos). Pearl jewelry, single strand necklace, pearl post earrings.

Fathers: Black tuxedo (no tails)

Mothers: Formal wear (floor length or ankle length)

Beaux Tuxedo Rental: All tuxedos are to be rented from Modern Brides for the 2023 Beautillion Ball. The package for the tuxedos includes everything except the black socks. The cost of the package is \$139.99 + tax. The tuxedo must be rented from Modern Brides, located at 822 Regal Drive SW, Huntsville, AL 35801, phone number 256-533-9333. You must be measured for the tuxedo between Monday, October 2, 2023, through Monday, October 16, 2023. Payment is due at the time of measurement. Upon the arrival of your tuxedo, you will be notified by phone, text, and/or email. You must be fitted at the store before you leave. Allow time for fitting in case alterations are needed. The return date for the tuxedo is Monday, November 20, 2023. If the tuxedo is not returned on time, a \$50.00 a day late fee will be charged. #### SERVICE PROJECT

We are doing incredible things throughout the community. The beaux are required to participate in a service project. Fun-Set Social and Charity Club is partnering with the **Kids to Love Foundation** in their Christmas for Kids Toy Drive. The Kids to Love Foundation is Non-Profit Organization 501 (c) (3) whose first commitment is to find *"forever families for foster children."* They are continually working to create those lifelong bonds by recruiting adoptive parents. Every week their founder and CEO, Lee Marshall, a former foster and adoptive child herself, shares with the Tennessee Valley stories of children waiting to be adopted. Out of 350 children featured in the weekly Kids to Love segment, 300 of them have found forever families. Beaux are asked to bring new toys for boys and girls from ages 5-14. Most needed items include: Legos, remote control cars, drones, stem toys, coding robots, rainbow high dolls, Disney character dolls/toys, purses, jewelry/necklaces, arts and crafts. The Fun-Set Social and Charity Club proudly offers two types of awards: Scholarship and Essay. These awards are designed to promote superior educational standards, enhanced writing skills, and leadership development in young African American male high school students. The purpose of the academic awards is to assist deserving students who have demonstrated the ability to compete academically.

## THE AMMON, RHODES, AND BRIGGS EDUCATION FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Academic – This scholarship is offered under the Ammons, Rhodes and Briggs Educational Fund. Four academic awards are given after the registrar certifies enrollment in a four-year college, university, community college, or trade school. The scholarship awards include: One \$1500.00 academic scholarship, One \$1200.00 academic scholarship, and two \$1000.00 academic scholarships.

#### Criteria:

Must sell a minimum of 12 tickets and two full-page ads in addition to all other solicited ads.

- 1. Must be enrolled in a public, private, or church school.
- 2. Must have a grade point average of 3.0 or better to qualify.
- 3. Submit an official transcript from your respective high school. The transcript must be an official copy with the school seal intact. No personal copies of a transcript will be accepted.
- 4. When requesting payment for Academic Scholarship, you must submit a letter from the Registrar's Office stating that you are currently enrolled in college, university, m community college or tade school.

All scholarship information must be submitted on time (Scholarship deadline September 24, 2023. ) No late information will be accepted. There will be no exceptions.

**Essay -** The Essay Scholarship is an excellent way to assist with paying for your future educational endeavors. Two five-hundred-dollar (\$500.00) scholarships are awarded.

#### Criteria:

Must sell a minimum of 12 tickets and two full-page ads in addition to all other solicited ads.

- 1. Must be enrolled in a public, private, or church school.
- 2. Must write a 500-word essay on the theme "Young Men of Excellence: Tomorrow's Leaders Start Today."
- 3. Essay must be typed (Times New Roman 12 font) and double-spaced.
- 4. Must include a title page, with the participant's name (this page is not included in the word count).
- 5. A separate page must be included behind the title page with the theme of the essay only (this page is not included in the word count).
- 6. Essay will be independently judged on adherence to the theme, clarity and the above criteria.
- 7. When requesting payment for Essay Scholarship, you must submit a letter from the Registrar's Office, from your school, stating that you are currently enrolled.
- 8. Please submit a hard copy and an email copy of your essay. Email all essays to: essays@funsetsocialandcharityclub.org

Essays must be submitted on time (Scholarship deadline September 24, 2023.)

No late information will be accepted. There will be no exceptions.

#### 2023 BEULAH BALLARD TONEY COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

The Fun Set Social and Charity Club supports one of our founding members' Scholarship Award for Community Service. This 2023 Beulah Ballard Toney Community Service Award celebrates two Beaux who exemplified a deep commitment to community service. To be eligible for this award the applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Provide a transcript via email to verify that the applicate has a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- 2. Provide a history of their service to others via email (Please list service activities).
- 3. Provide two letters of recommendation via email by two people that support your service activities.
- 4. Applicant deadline for the Beulah Ballard Toney Scholarship Fund is October 13, 2023.

The scholarship funds will be delivered when the proof of course registration in a postsecondary educational institution university, college, community college, or trade school is submitted to BBT Scholarship Fund.
